

## Visa Advice

Travelling in Indonesia for any foreign nationals are required to possess a valid Travel Document and Entry Permit or Visa.

Some foreign nationals do not need to apply for a visa, namely those who are permitted to use **Free Visa for Short Visit (BVKS)**. Free Visa for Short Visit (BVKS) is a 30 (thirty) days Visa Free for a Short Visit, currently granted at any Immigration Check Point for citizens from the following countries:

- 1. Brunei Darussalam
- 2. Chile
- 3. Hong Kong SAR (Special Administration Region)
- 4. Macao SAR
- 5. Malaysia
- 6. Moroccan
- 7. Peru
- 8. Philippines
- 9. Singapore
- 10. Thailand
- 11. Vietnam
- 12. Ecuador

All other foreign nationals are required to obtain a Visa.

## Visa on Arrival to Indonesia

Citizens from 62 countries and 1 region are eligible for applying a Visa on Arrival (VOA).

This visa can be obtained directly when you arrive at certain airports (Including Adisucipto International Airport in Yogyakarta) and seaports in Indonesia, regardless of the purpose of your visit (Business, Tourist, Social-Cultural).

Visa on Arrival is neither a work visa nor a visit visa. Therefore, it can not be extended or converted into another immigration permit. The maximum stay permitted is thirty (30) days and could be extended (one time) for a maximum thirty (30) days.
